

CIOB Global Student Challenge 2023

The CIOB's competition for students from around the world has an exciting new format. Using a new interactive software platform, students will be given an imagined injection of cash from an anonymous donor, and will be asked to bid for the construction of a student focused campus facility.

Students will be asked to present a build that is radically different, and meets local technical, environmental, and social needs. Using locally sourced materials and skills, they will be tasked with the design and delivery of the facility through a thorough two stage selection process, replicating a real life building process. The finalists will go on to present their bid to a live panel of industry expert judges online.

The winning team will receive an all-expenses paid trip to CIOB Members' Forum* in the UK, to present their bid and test their ideas in the real world, with global industry experts giving feedback on the winning submission. The winning team also will receive a £2,000 cash prize!

It's a six month campaign, as call for entry starts in January, with the rounds taking place in February – April. The lucky winners are announced in April, ready to prepare for their all-expenses paid trip in June.
